

Yosemite Accommodations

Climb to your heart's content or ride the rapids till you get tired of it. Yosemite National Park has adventures that will convince you to stay an extra day or two.

Visitors who are not only stopping by the Yosemite National Park for a day trip wouldn't find any problem with Yosemite accommodations. Guests are left with a wide choice of lodging within and near the park. The numerous options will cater to the varied interests of the park visitors. Although all strive to ensure that the best Yosemite experience is given to every guest, each of the Yosemite accommodations has a particular feature that makes it distinctly different from the others.

The DNC Parks and Resorts at Yosemite, Inc. provide all the Yosemite accommodations found within the premises of the Yosemite National Park. The National Park Service appointed it as the official concessionaire. They offer discounted Yosemite accommodations and provide discounts to the Yosemite Association members.

The Yosemite Valley is practically the most popular tourist destination inside the Yosemite National Park. Hence, some of the best Yosemite accommodations are found in this area. Such lodging providers are: The Ahwahnee, with its 24 cottages and 99 luxury hotel rooms, is one of the top options; Yosemite Lodge consists of 245 motel-type-rooms; Curry Village boasts of its 103 cabins each with its own bath, 80 cabins that are provided with a central bath, 427 tent cabins, and 18 motel-type rooms; Housekeeping Camps made up of 266 old-fashioned type of lodging units. All these Yosemite accommodations are conveniently located near the Yosemite Village which houses several visitor services like the Valley Visitor Center.

Just because the Yosemite Valley is the most frequented area in the park doesn't mean that it is the only one that has Yosemite accommodations. Lodging is actually available in other parts of the park as well, some of these are: The Wawona Hotel consists of 104 rooms and is easily located near the south entrance of the Yosemite National Park; 24 tent cabins and four cabins each with its own private bath makes up the White Wolf Lodge; Tuolumne Meadows Lodge purely provides canvas tent cabin accommodations with its 69 units; The High Sierra Camp is interestingly made up of five camping grounds, all of which provide canvas tent cabins. The last three options for Yosemite accommodations are all highly crowded in the summer and are closed for the winter.

With a lot of alternatives for Yosemite accommodations within the park, tourists really don't need to look far to find a perfect place for them to stay. And what better way to spend the night than to have nature right outside your doorstep? Surreal, but positively so.

Yosemite Hotels

Planning to visit Yosemite National Park? Wondering if there are hotels in the area where you can stay for a whole night or two? Well, visitors to Yosemite National Park are given a wide selection of accommodations within and outside the national park. The Yosemite hotels are available to provide visitors the accommodations that fit nearly all levels of budget. So don't worry anymore. You can visit and explore Yosemite National Park anytime you want to and you can stay in the hotels of your choice to your heart's desire.

To give you an idea of what hotels are now available in Yosemite region, I have given below a short list of the most visited of

Ahwahnee Hotel

Built in 1927, Ahwahnee Hotel has been considered as one of the grandest Yosemite hotels. It boasts a distinct architecture influenced by the Native American, Arts and Crafts, Middle Eastern and Art Deco styles. Also, Ahwahnee Hotel is noted for its beamed ceilings, set of Native American artwork that is richly colored, stone hearts, granite façade, and of course, rooms that are well-designed and well-equipped.

Wawona Hotel

Wawona Hotel is actually the oldest mountain resort hotel in the state of California. Being the oldest, this Yosemite hotel is considered by many as a national historic landmark. The inside and outside of this facility boast a classic style, but the rooms have no air conditioning. It has about 104 guest rooms available, with about 50 private bathrooms. Aside from that, the place offers free parking, golf and tennis courts, swimming tank which is open in summer, and a number of dining room located on its premises. This hotel is located near the south entrance of the Mariposa Grove and it's almost an hour drive from the Valley.

Yosemite Lodge

Nestled on the Yosemite Valley, Yosemite Lodge is one of the well-known Yosemite hotels that provide visitors a wide selection of dining options and motel-style rooms. This place is very much popular for visitors coming in large tour groups, so it's no wonder that this hotel can get crowded at times. Just like the other Yosemite hotels, this too has no air conditioning, but it offers a

wireless internet connection, room service, and heated outdoor swimming pools.

There are a lot more well-known hotels in Yosemite region that can give you a wide selection of great accommodations. Other choices may include the Tenaya Lodge, Evergreen Lodge, Best Western Yosemite Gateway Inn, Yosemite West, and Curry Village. It is important to note that most of these Yosemite hotels offer their accommodations pretty expensive. The nightly rates usually vary by season, so it is important to contact the Yosemite hotels of your choice before you start your travel.
